SB 969

California will require that all residential garage door openers sold in the state on or after July 1, 2019, must be equipped with a battery backup (BBU) function. The bill was introduced in January 2018 in response to the 2017 wildfires that left some people trapped in their garage. At least five deaths were reported to have some connection to automatic garage door openers that had no power.

This law prohibits a person, corporation, or entity from manufacturing, selling, offering for sale, or installing in California a residential garage door opener "that does not have a battery backup function that is designed to operate when activated because of an electrical outage." Openers also require the battery backup to be "operational without interruption during an electrical outage."

Violations of these provisions subject to a civil penalty of \$1,000 "per opener installed, manufactured, sold, or offered for sale." The law also prohibits a replacement residential garage door from being connected to an existing garage door opener that does not have a battery backup, regardless of the manufacture date of the opener.
